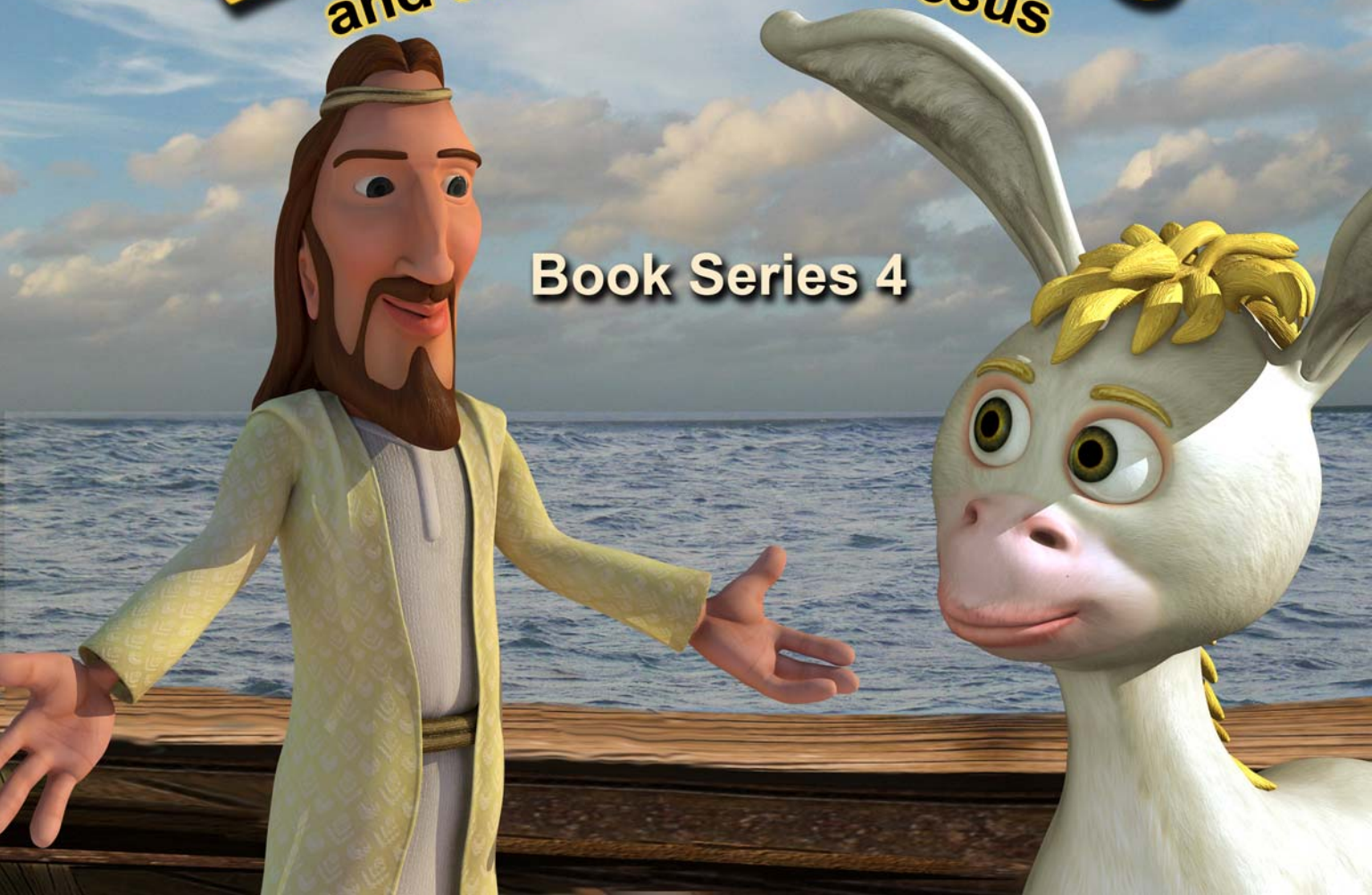

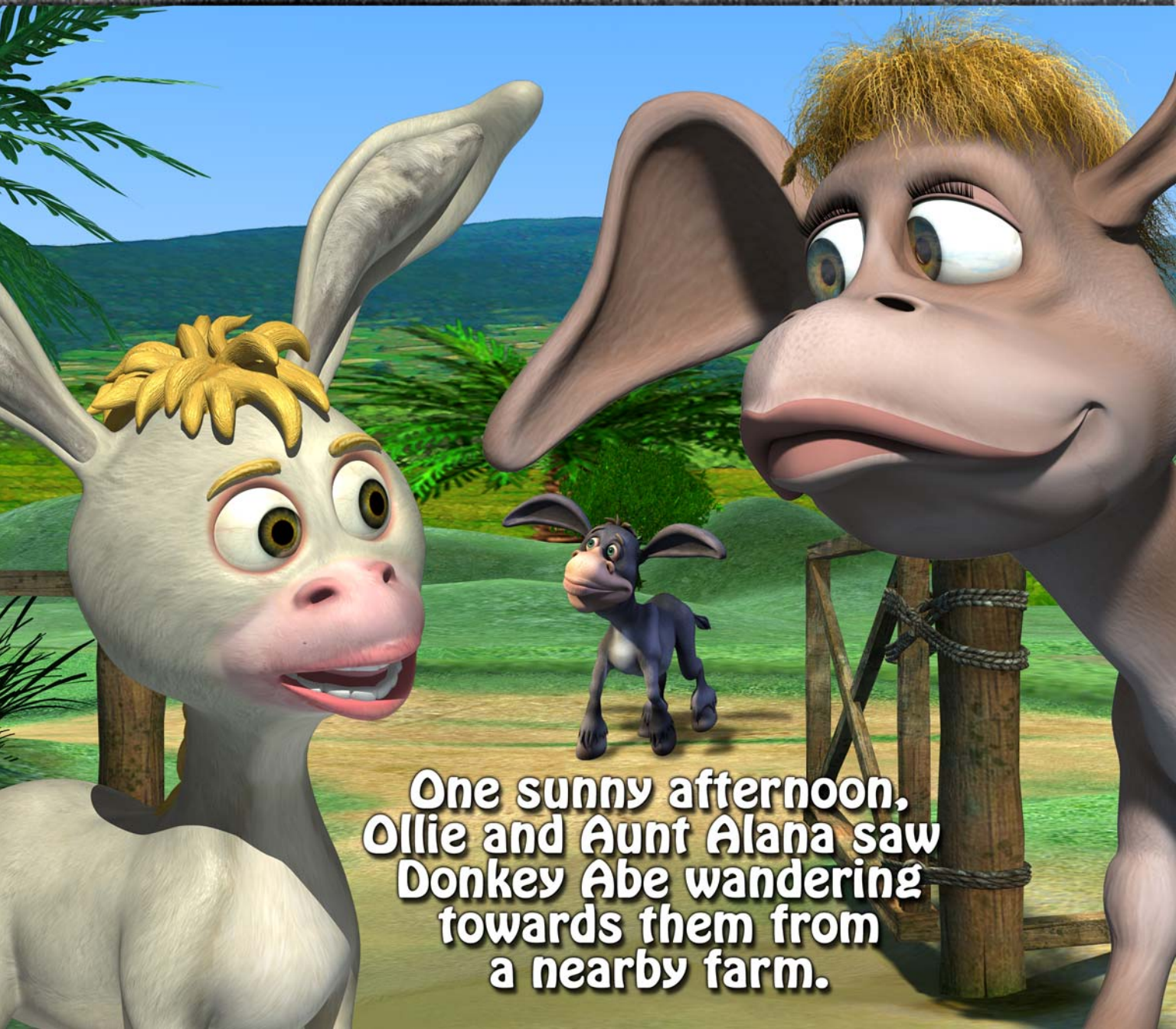

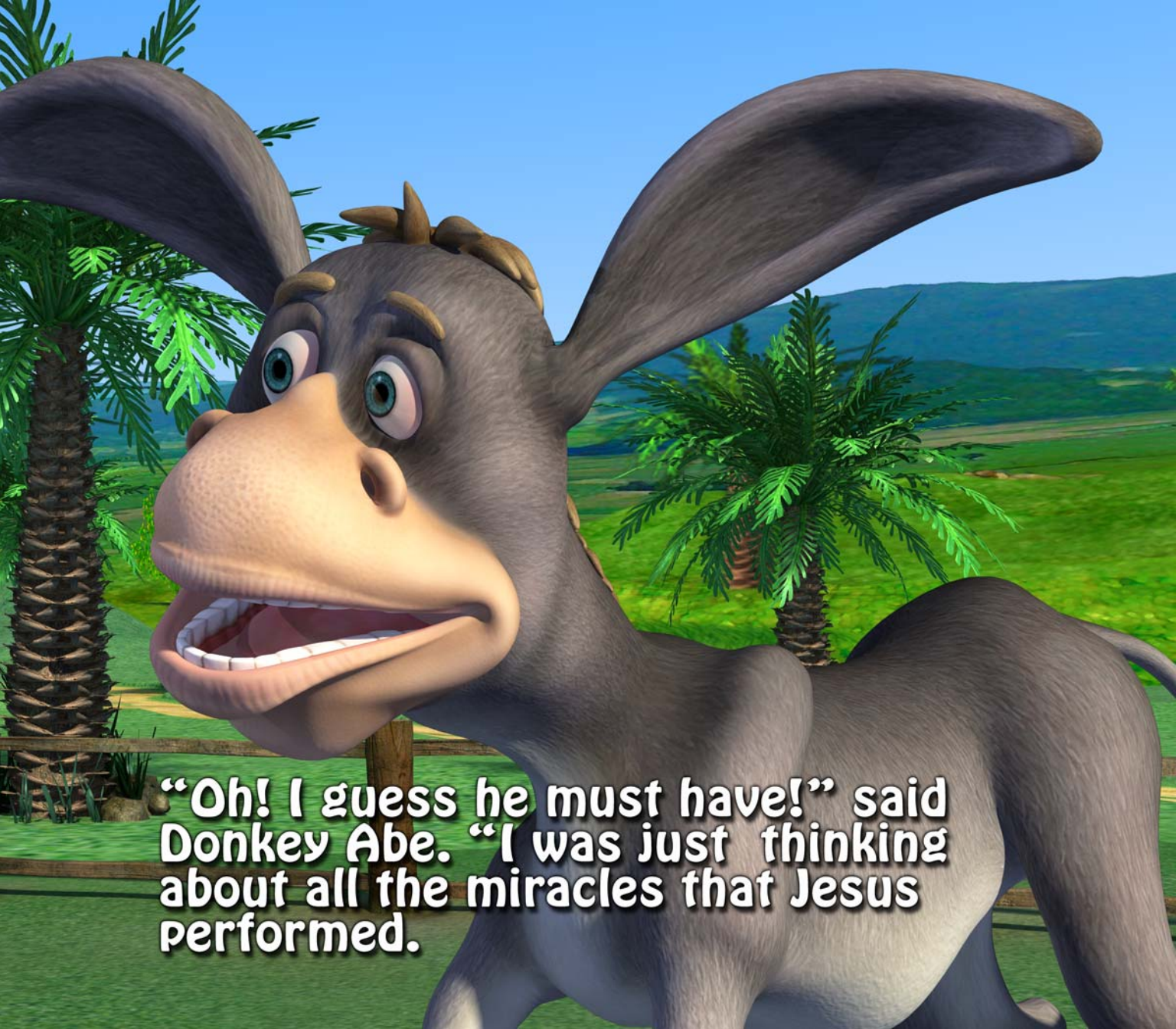




**One sunny afternoon,

“But Abe said that Jesus performed miracles,” said Ollie.

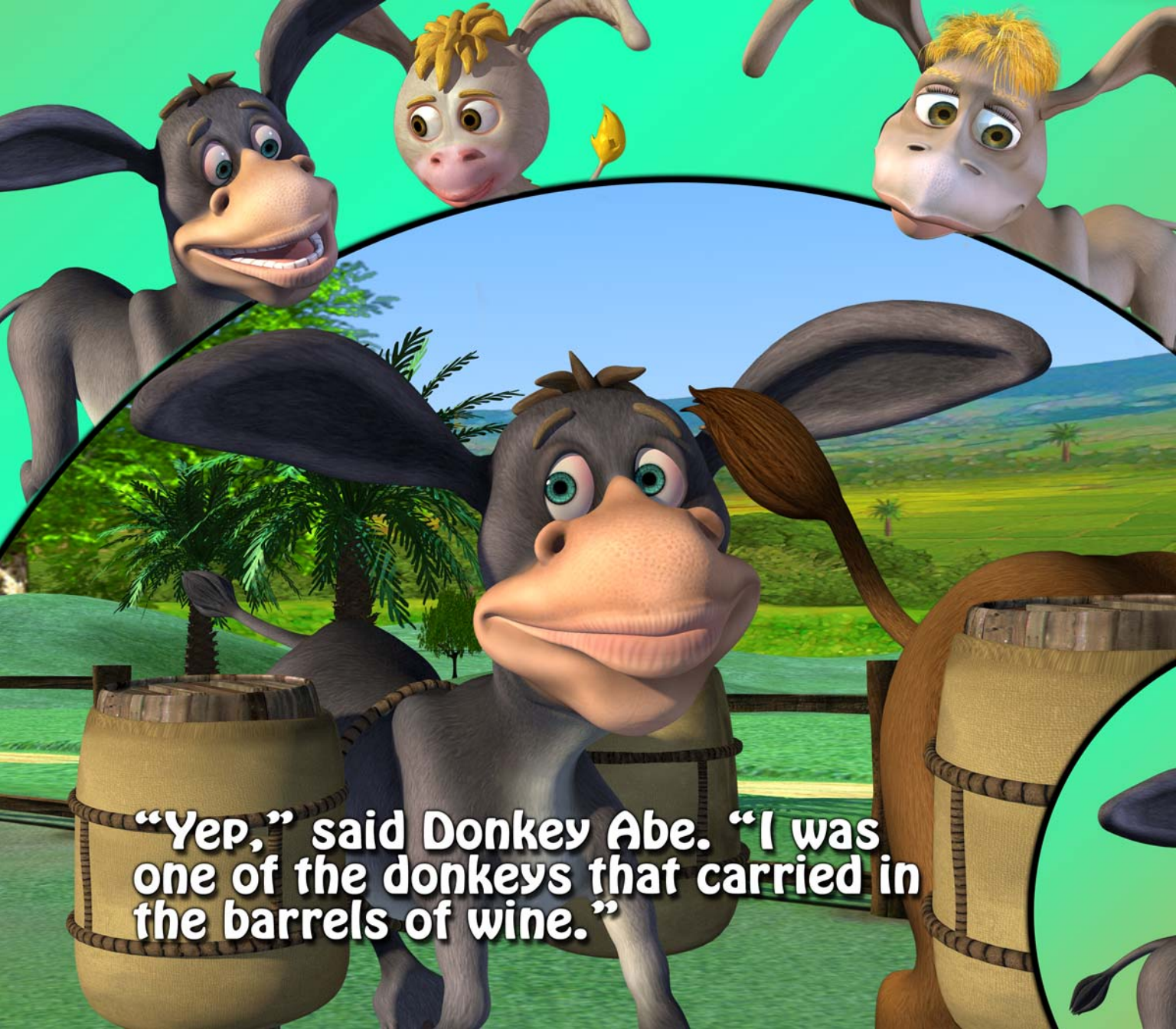


**“God gave Jesus

“but I once saw a really BIG catch!”**



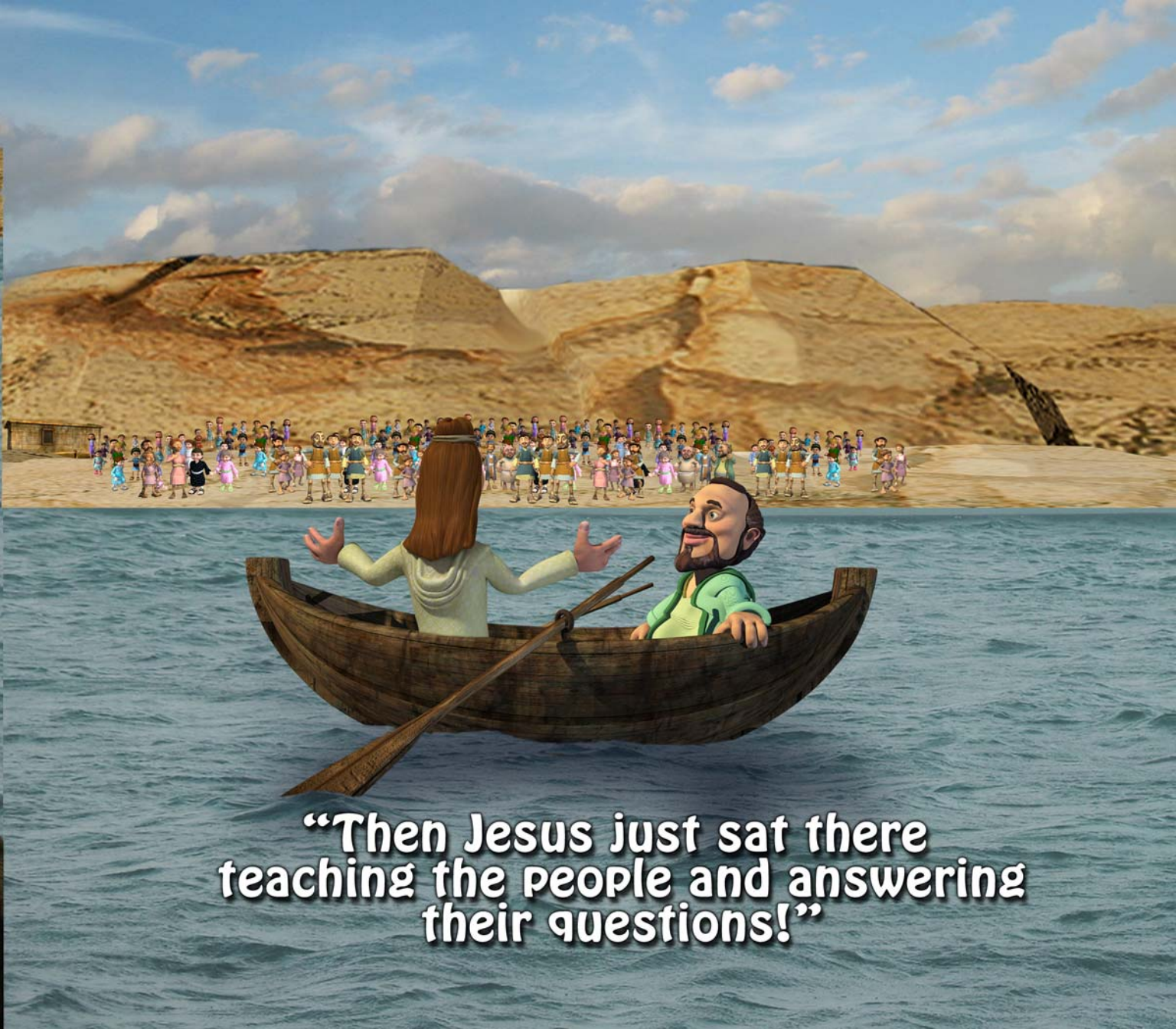


“Oh?” asked Ollie.

“He called to some friends to come and help him. And even THEN there were so many fish the two boats almost sank!”



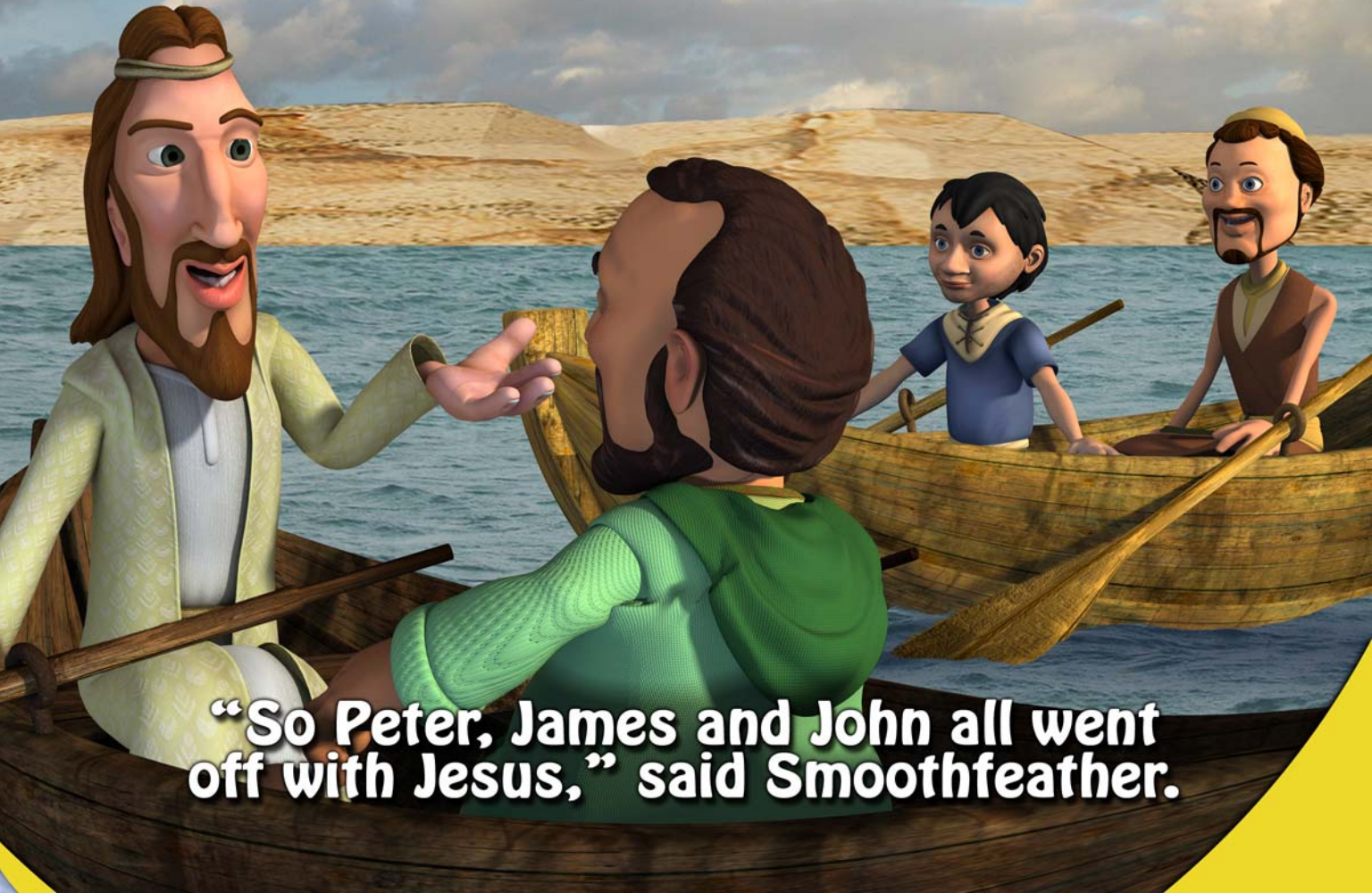
“I had never seen so many fish!” said Smoothfeather.

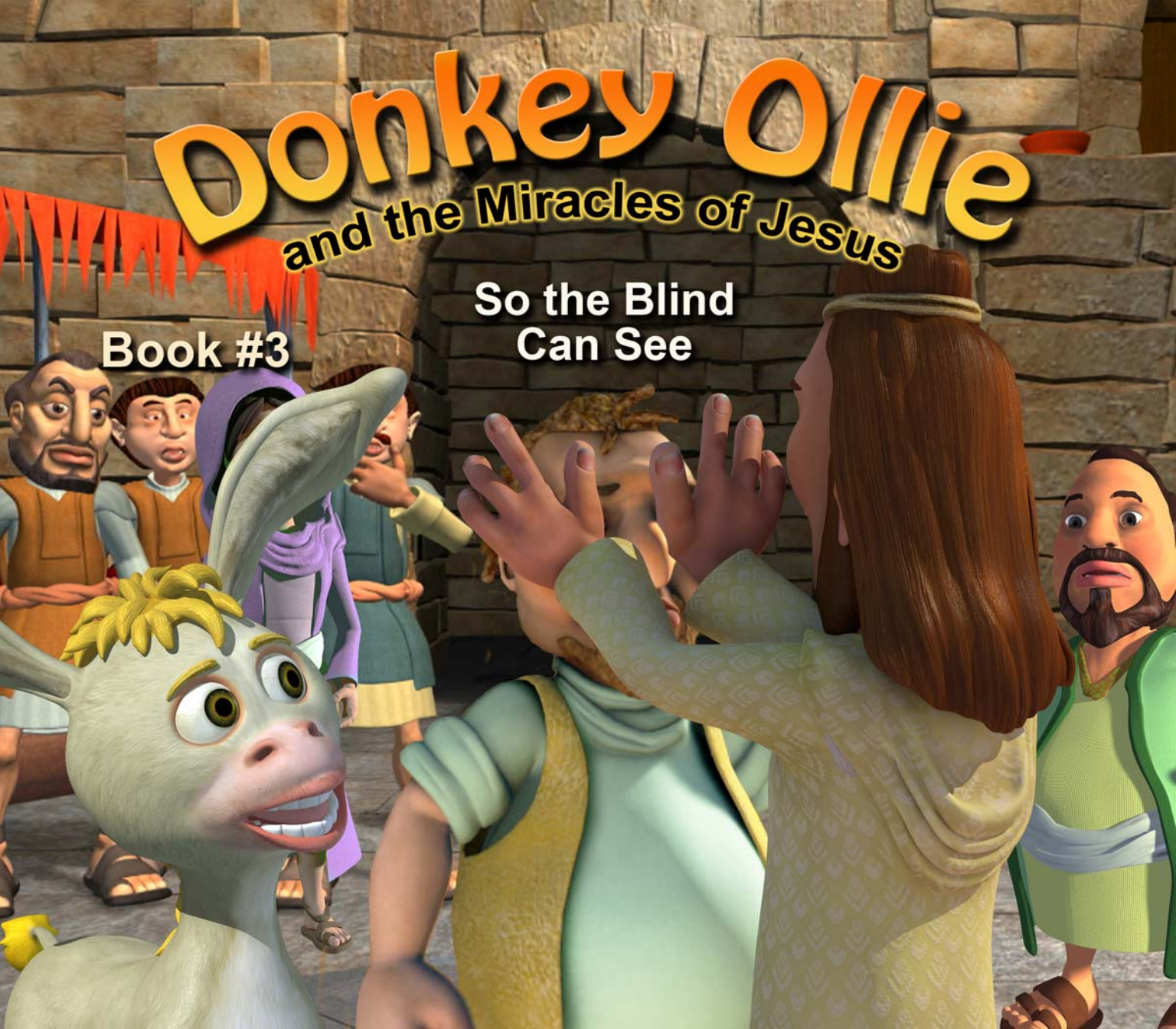

asked Jeremy.**

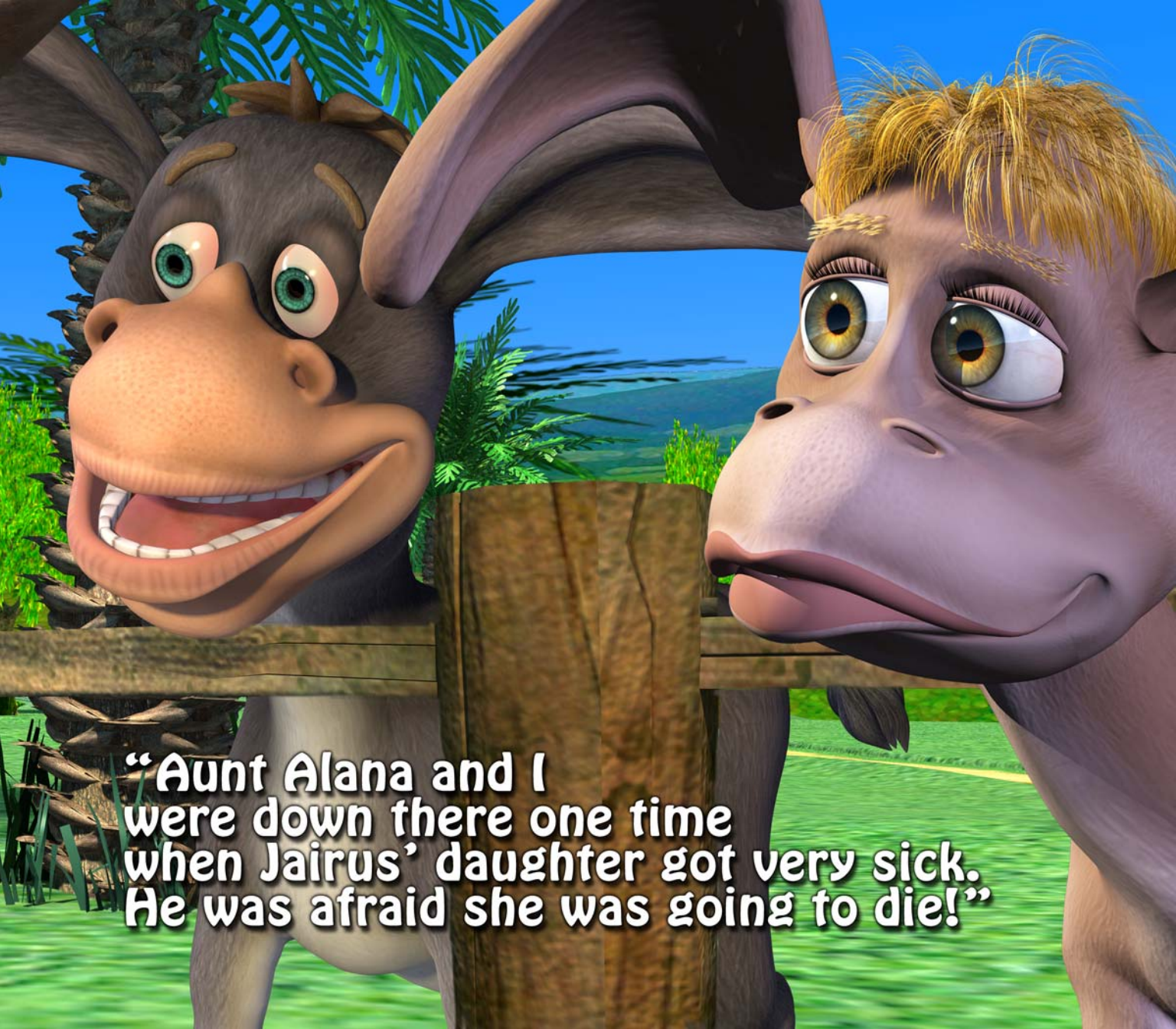

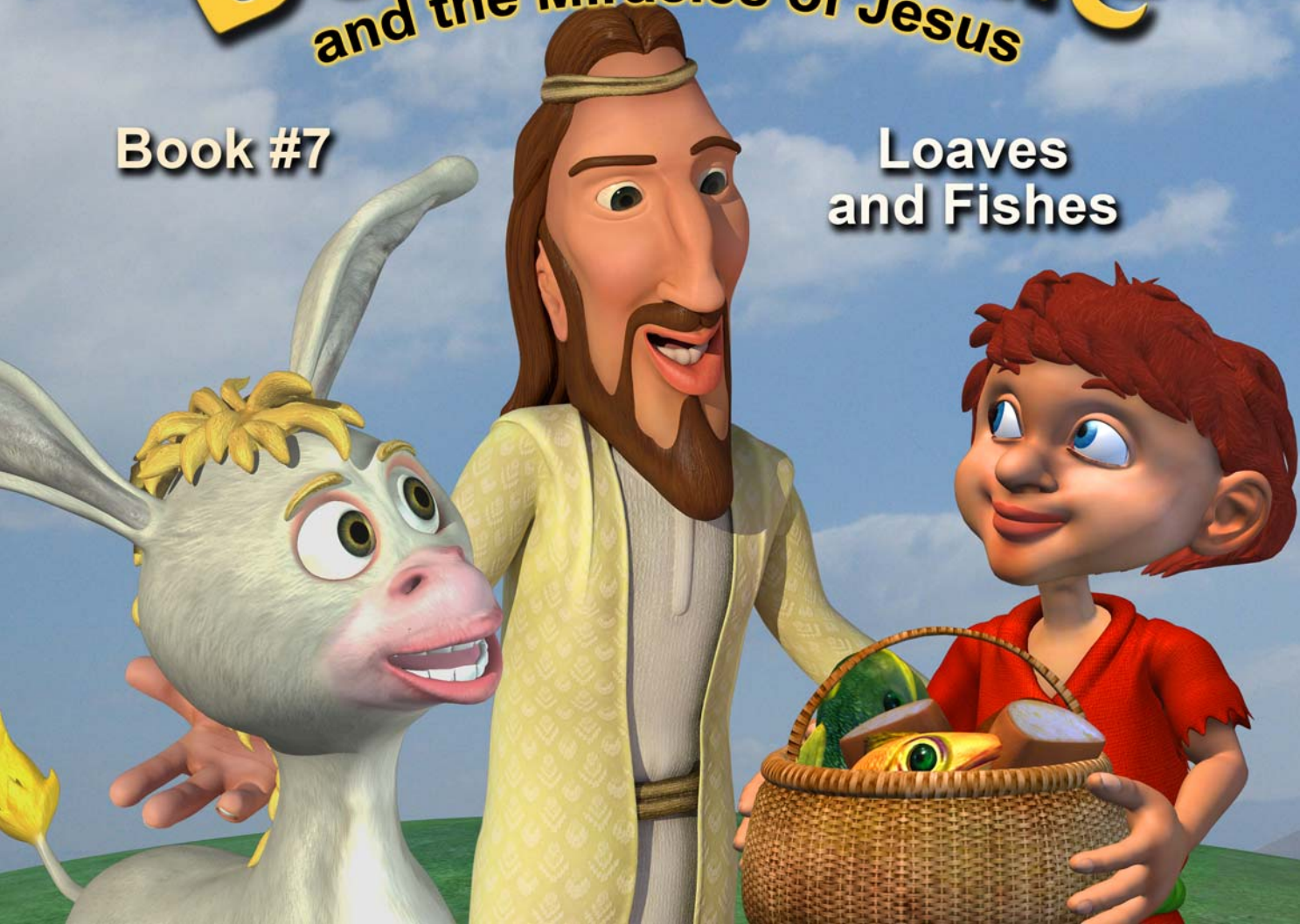

“The three of us went to hear Jesus speak. It was up on a hillside, and there were a lot of people.”

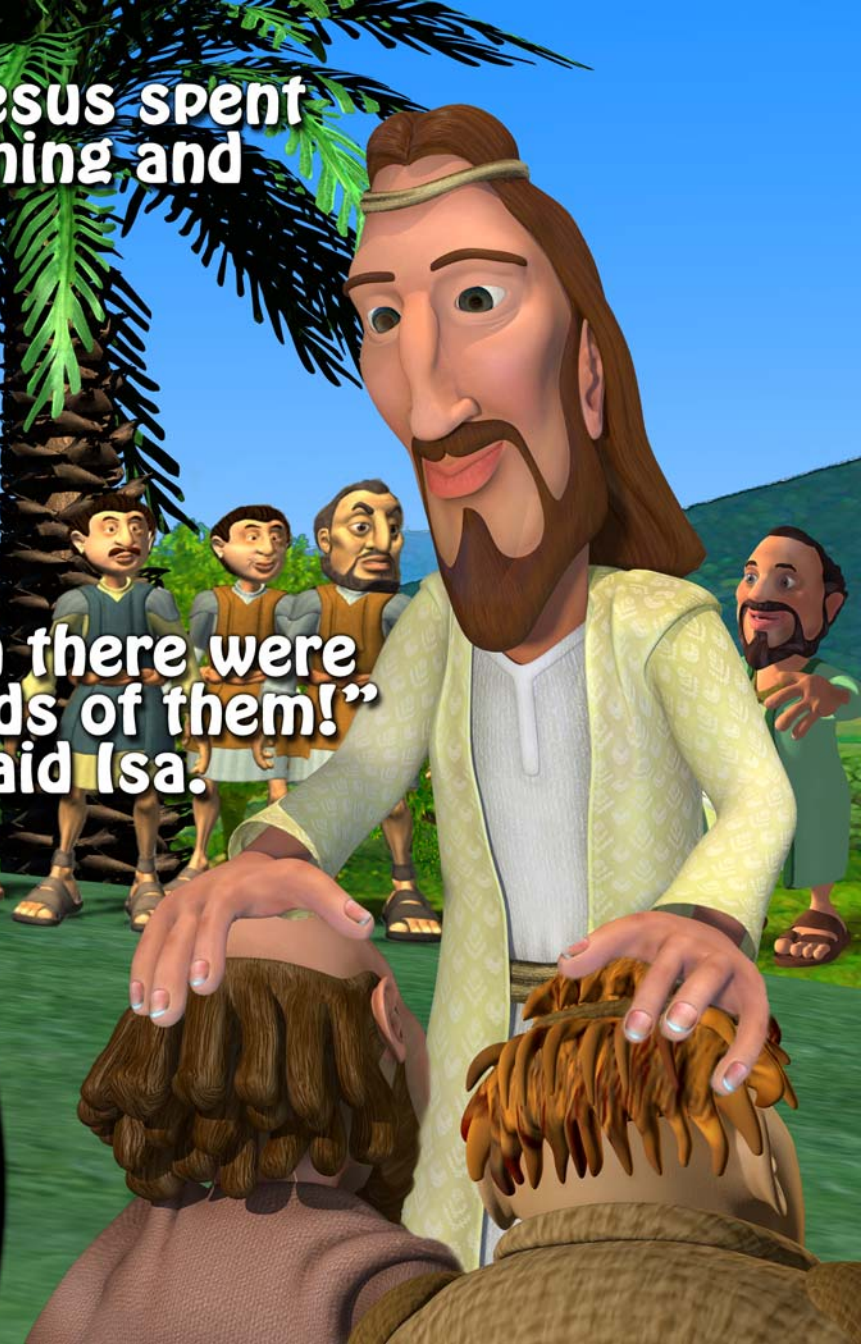
**“The place with the sweet, sweet grass?”

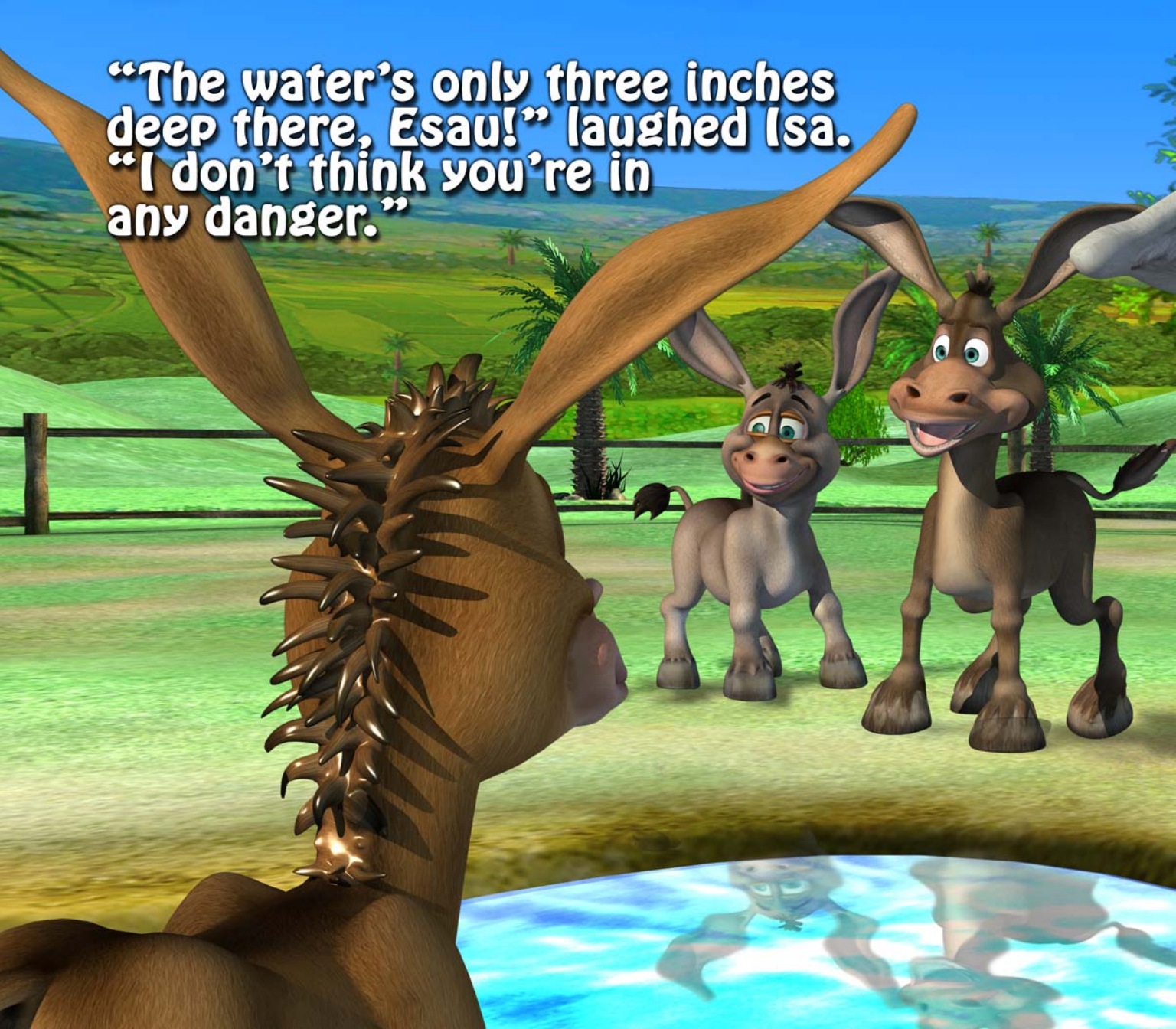

“Tell us about it!” urged Ollie.

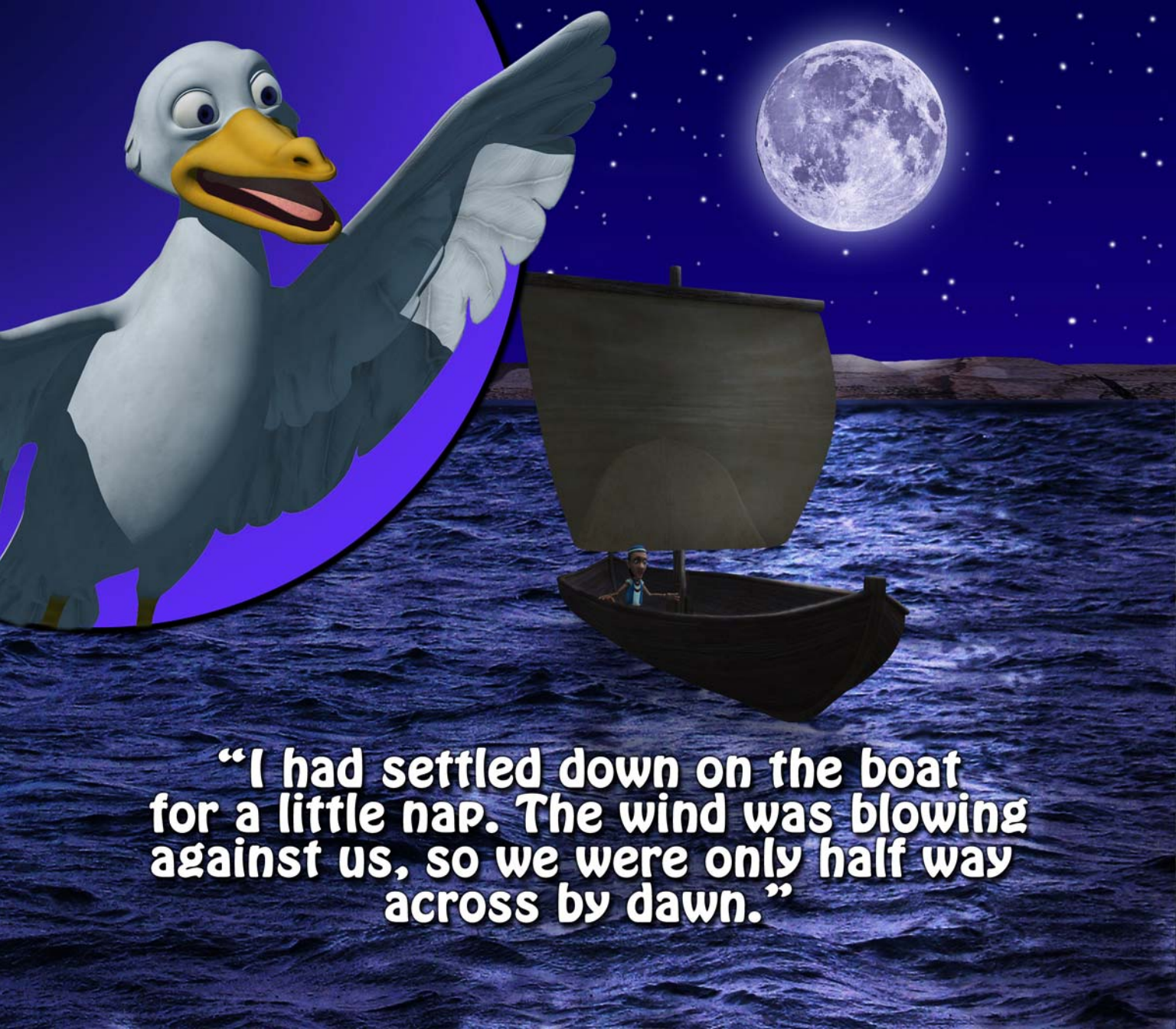
**“Well,” began Smoothfeather,

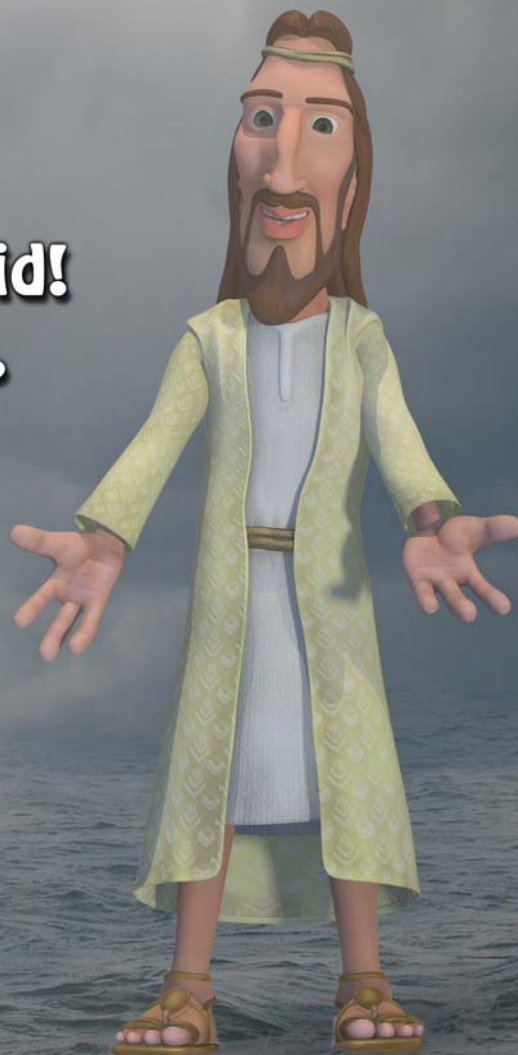



Lazarus had been his good friend.”**




**“ ‘Roll the rock away
